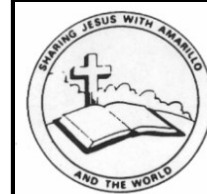

Please review the names on our prayer list (on the other side of this sheet) and **keep them all in your prayers.**

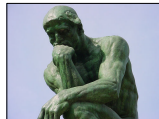

## How Can We Help Those Who are Suffering?

**We all have burdens and deal with suffering.** Matthew 5:45 says, *"that you may be sons of your Father in heaven; for He makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust."* Being treated equally is first introduced in Scripture. Regardless of the demographic we represent, everyone deals with challenges. God shows grace and care for all His creatures; as Jesus' disciples, we are to imitate God. We are to love those who are challenged with health, social, emotional, and financial challenges. Christians are to love the sick, the well, their neighbor and their enemy.

Helping those who suffer will require Christians to apply Scripture with a period and not a question mark.
