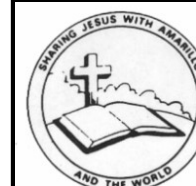

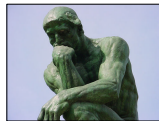
On the Lighter Side ...

Thank You Mom!



"Honor your father and mother—which is the first commandment with a promise—that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth" (Eph 6:2-3). In a little town in Taylor County West Virginia Anna Jarvis in 1907 began a campaign to establish a national Mother's Day. The special day would fall on the anniversary of her mother's death. So on May 10, 1908 the day was observed in Philadelphia Pennsylvania where Jarvis had recently moved. It wasn't until 1914 that president Woodrow Wilson made the official announcement to the nation that every second Sunday of May would be a national day of observance.

Mother's Day is a special day in which we take a moment to honor the women who make a difference in our lives. In my years of Christian service I had the privilege of interviewing senior statesmen, great community leaders and church leaders who are making a difference in all of our lives. In our first few weeks after moving to Logansport Indiana I was given a personal invitation to meet with Mayor Michael Fincher. Mayor Fincher impressed me as he spoke in tears about his mother. I am convinced that the world is a better place because of all mothers that were readers, teachers and fitting examples. Dedicated mothers produce determined children. We all know that it takes a considerable amount of determination to make a difference in today's world.

So take some time this Mother's Day to remember Mom. The apostle Paul reminds his "son in the faith" (Timothy) where his personal faith originated. "I have been reminded of your sincere faith, which first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice and, I am persuaded, now lives in you also" (2 Tim. 1:5).

The Heavens Declare



"The heavens declare the glory of God and the skies proclaim His handiwork" (Psalm 19:1). Our DNA contains instructions for building proteins out of sequences of amino acids. There are 500 or so known amino acids, but life uses only 23. The average protein in a cell is about 450 amino acids long so there are 23 to the 450th power or 10 to the 613th power different proteins our DNA might construct. Life uses about 10 million proteins. If we took those 10 possible proteins and split them into planet-proportioned groups of 10 million each, there would be 10 to the 606th power groups. Astronomers tell us there are 10 to the 23rd power habitable planets at a maximum in the universe, so you could spread those groups of proteins over the planets in 10 to the 583rd power universes without having a single duplication of a single protein on any two planets. Planet earth and the life on it are special, unique and not accidental. Church, our God is an awesome Creator. Glory be to His holy name!
